

Horatio Board met in regular session on Monday, October 9. Annual report to the public by Superintendent, Lee Smith and Title I report by Federal Programs Coordinator, Tammy McAlister.

Election of board officers was held and the following would hold these positions: President- Elizabeth Walker, Vice-President – Sherri Hodges, and Secretary – Jeffrey Irvan.
